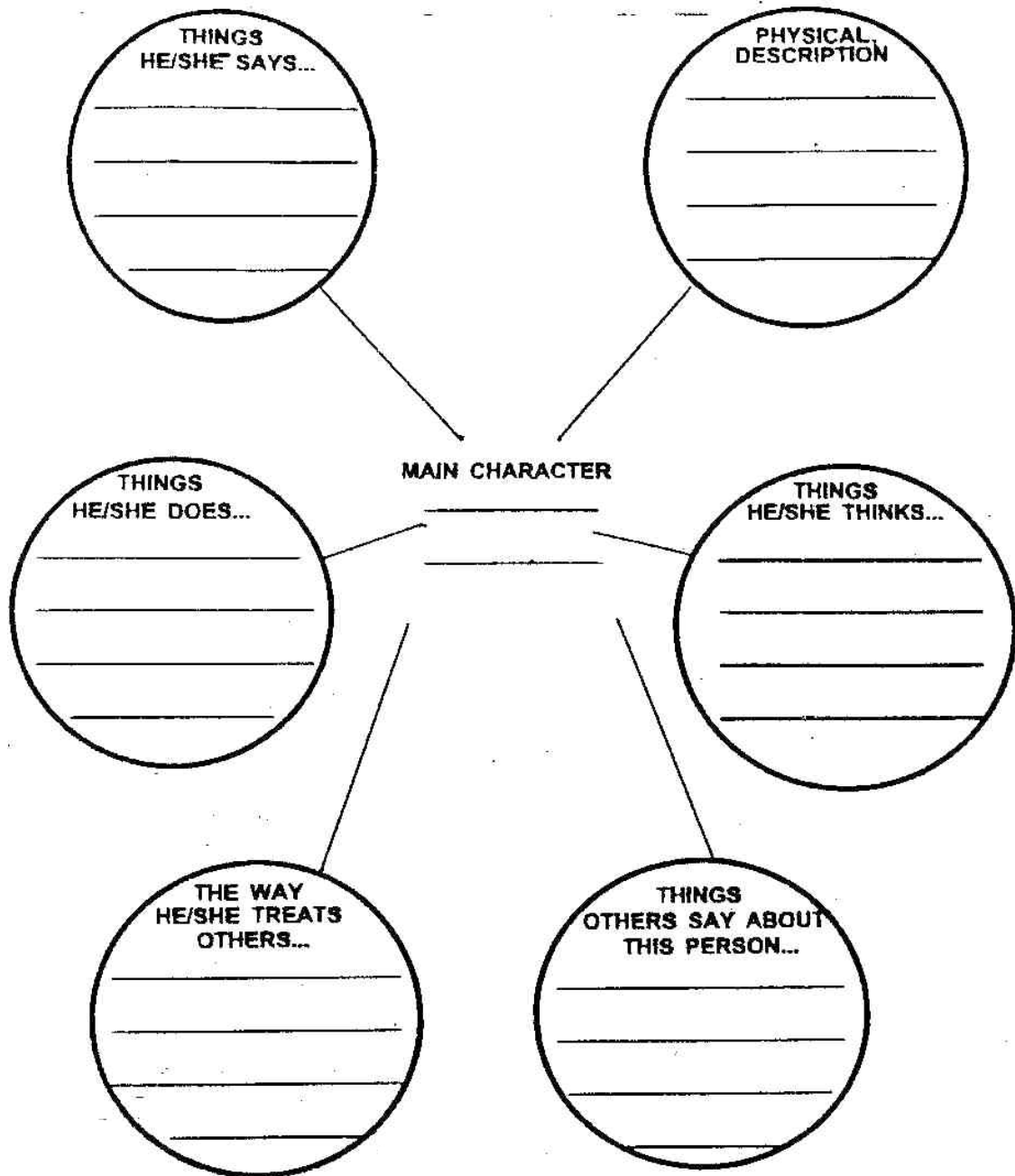

Methods of Characterization	Examples from the Selection and What They Reveal about the Characters
Indirect Characterization	
<p>The character is revealed through his/her own speech.  <i>Example: John looked suspiciously at the stranger and repeated himself, "I said Howdy, Paatnaa."</i></p>	
<p>The writer describes how the character looks and dresses.  <i>Example: He was muscular with a large head and broad shoulders. He wore a red flannel shirt with blue jeans that were soiled from hard work in the woods.</i></p>	
<p>The character's private thoughts are revealed.  <i>Example: Allen thought to himself, "I shouldn't be afraid, I shouldn't be afraid."</i></p>	
<p>The writer reveals what other characters in the story say or think about the character.  <i>Example: Jane told me that Sarah was making fun of the other kids.</i></p>	
<p>The writer show what the character does – how he or she acts.  <i>Example: She gave the boy her last dime.</i></p>	
Direct Characterization	

The writer directly states what kind of person the character is: sneaky, honest, evil, innocent, and so on.

*Example: Katrian was a shy girl.*



# Character

Everything a writer does to portray <sup>character</sup> ~~writer~~ is part of characterization



## Notes on Character:

- The writer's job is to make the personalities of the characters clear and believable to the reader

## Methods of Characterization:

- Showing the character's appearance
- Displaying the character's thoughts
- Letting the character speak; and
- Getting the reactions of others



## Characters are presented in 2 ways

- **Direct:** The author tell us straight out what type of character they are

*Example: The author says straight out "He was an extremely troubled man who was haunted by his past"*

- **Indirect:** The author shows us what type of character they are through their actions in the story (what the character does, says or thinks)

*Example: Because the character is always worried and stressed about his past, we can conclude that he is an extremely troubled man*
